
FARMER INFORMATION SHEET

Southern Piedmont Climate-Smart Project Details

The Southern Piedmont Climate-Smart project is partnering with organic and conventional diverse vegetable farmers in the region to add cover crops to their vegetable rotation. We will monitor greenhouse gas emissions, soil health benefits and economic and social barriers to change over four years. This information will provide farmers with the data needed to capitalize on carbon market programs and understand how they can act to better steward their lands and communities. It will also enable us to provide the USDA with recommendations for supporting farmers transitioning to climate-smart agriculture.

Southern Piedmont Climate-Smart Project Requirements for Farmer Participation:

- Diverse vegetable farmer in the southern Piedmont with or willing to get a USDA Farm Service agency number
- Acreage may not be enrolled in other NRCS cost-share programs for same practices
- Willing to enroll 2-10 acres in the project for 4 years
- Follow project planting and cover cropping rotation provided
- Utilize provided technical assistance related to the project
- Input data via phone application
- Participation in related practice training
- Allow project team scheduled access to enrolled acres for data collection
